This bulletin is reprinted for four reasons: - 1. To emphasize the necessity of careful organization, especially in the first four grades. The daily programs for two-teacher and three-teacher schools are especially recommended for careful examination. Every school receiving State aid must file with the State Superintendent a copy of each teacher s daily program before this aid can be paid. 2. To call attention to the supplementary reading books, and, incidentally, to the 1914 Library List. 3. To urge proper equipment in each classroom. In many schools this minimum equipment can be improved, especially in blackboards, maps and desks. 4. In the hope of stimulating lagging communities to take advantage of the rural graded school Act. Each school should file at the end of the first month its application for State aid during the current year....
